### A Note from the Principal

Learning to read is one of the most important things that we can teach our students to set them up for lifelong success. "The inability to read is associated with lifelong consequences such as lower academic achievement, dropping out of school, diminished earning potential, higher risk for incarceration, and less access to resources that can help alleviate physical and mental health challenges." There is much evidence that shows if students have not learned the foundational reading skills by the end of first grade, they are highly likely to experience chronic reading difficulties. The good news is that we can prevent and reduce reading problems! One of the ways to ensure that students have a strong reading foundation is to teach: phonemic awareness skills, phonics skills, fluency and comprehension and written expression.

#### Things you can do as a parent to help support your student as an early reader:

- Read to your student.
- Ask questions about their reading before, during and after.
- Have your student read at home 15 to 20 minutes each night.
- · Encourage writing.
- Ensure that your student is at school and on time.
- Reach out to your child's teacher if you need resources.
- Point out print and words in your child's environment.



# WHAT IS MATH FACT FLUENCY?



EACH GRADE LEVEL HAS IT'S OWN STANDARDS FOR FLUENCY

Kindergarten: counting by 1s and 10s to 100, addition and subtraction within 5

1st grade: addition and subtraction within 10

2nd grade: addition and subtraction within 10

3rd grade: multiplication and division with single digits

4th and 5th grade: addition and subtraction of multi-digit numbers, extend and apply multiplication and division fluency

Math fact fluency is the quick, effortless, and automatic recall of basic math facts in all four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division).

When students achieve automaticity, they can retrieve math facts from their long-term memory without conscious effort or attention (or counting on their fingers!). This allows them to devote more time to advanced problem-solving and learning new skills. Fact fluency not only saves students time but also significantly impacts their future math success.
